



Intern Scholarship Application

Deadline: Anytime between January 1 – April 15

The Intern Scholarship shall be awarded to an intern working for an Active Member's institution.

The proposals should include:

- The NEHES member's name and title.
- Member Institution and address.
- A description of the member's facilities.
- An outline of the project, including the number of hours the intern would be utilized and the expected hourly wage to be paid.
- A short narrative on how the completion of the work will benefit the member's organization.
- The qualifications required of a student intern in your organization.
- The learning objectives of the intern.
- If a partial scholarship is awarded, is your organization prepared to subsidize the balance?
- Name and address at the Healthcare institution to which the check may be sent. *Checks will not be mailed until the intern has worked for 4 weeks or more.*

Intern Scholarships shall be awarded on a rolling basis until all funds have been allocated. The maximum that may be awarded for an intern scholarship is \$2,000.
